NATIONAL PONY SOCIETY / TopSpec SUPREME DRESSAGE

CHAMPIONSHIP is a competition to encourage both performance and education of British Bred ponies and their riders. Qualifiers will run from the 1st of April 2011 through to 31st March, 2012 and culminate in the NPS/TopSpec Supreme Dressage Championship Final to be held at Addington Manor Equestrian Centre in April 2012. The competition will be run under NPS Dressage Rules in 2011/2012 and will be judged by British Dressage Judges. Each test will consist of six sections all of which will have their own Final. The two highest placed ponies in each section will qualify for the 2012 Final.

Sections are open to:

1. Registered Mountain & Moorland breeds not exceeding 138cms
2. Registered Mountain & Moorland breeds exceeding 138cms
3. Registered British Riding Ponies
4. Part Bred horses/ponies registered with the appropriate Native Part Bred Stud Book
5. Highest placed Mini rider aged under 12 years on 1st January 2011.
6. Highest placed Junior rider under 18 years on 1st January 2011

All qualifiers will receive Sponsor's rosettes and cards.

Horses/ponies must be ridden at the Final by the qualifying rider

Those qualifying for the Final must become fully paid up Dressage/Showing Members of the NPS for 2012 in order to compete at the 2012 NPS/TopSpec Final.

The Champion winners of each section Final for each test will be required to perform a 4.5 minute freestyle to Music for the judging of the overall NPS/TopSpec Supreme Dressage Title.

Please state on your entry form which section you wish to compete in.

VETERAN HORSE OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES 2011

The 3 highest placed competitors with a horse or pony of 15years of age and over gaining a 60% test score and above will qualify for the National Finals on the **17th/18th Sept at Rodbaston College** in Staffordshire. There are 3 qualification cards available in each section. Competitors do **not need to be a member of VHS/VHD**. Competitors will have 10 days to return their Qualification card and then register to VH Dressage Head Office. This must be accompanied by a full photo copy of the Horse/Pony Passport to verify the animals age.
